

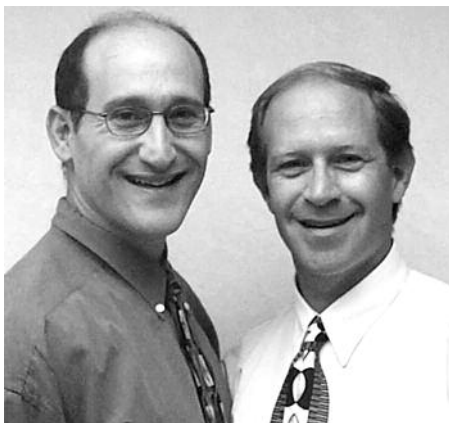
Ask The Dentists

Question: Dear Dr. Winter, I have worn dentures for 10 yrs. I just got new ones and now I cannot bite or chew anything. I never had this problem with my other dentures, why now? P.K.

Answer: Dear P.K. As I have not seen your previous dentures or your current dentures, I can not comment on the reasons you are having problems. If the dentures are loose, it could be the impression technique that was used. If you are hitting unevenly, it could be your bite and a simple adjustment could improve your situation! You should discuss this with your dentist. They should be able to take measurements from your old to your new dentures to show you the tooth size, positions, and changes that have been made. I hope they solve your issues. If not you may call us at 414-464-9021 for a consultation visit.

Question: Dear Dr. Winter, I am desperate for some help. I will travel. I had all of my top teeth pulled on 12/09/09. I have never been able to wear the dentures made for me and now I am on my second pair. Between the pain, and bone loss in the jaw I am miserable and I need some help, the pain is excruciating. Please help me.

Answer: Dear Karen, I am sorry for your problems. You certainly can come to Milwaukee for treatment but it could take a few visits over two weeks to create new dentures for you. Certainly, your goal should always be to place implants to preserve your bone, prevent dentures from abrading away your existing bone and recreating a beautiful smile that is non-removable. That being said, dentures still need to be comfortable and beautiful so they may be used as a prototype restoration for use with implant dentistry in the future.
